In the matter of Union Electric Company
of St. Louis, Missouri, for authority
to file revised tariffs for incandescent
lighting service provided to customers in
the Missouri service area of the company.

SUSPENSION ORDER

On December 26, 1979, Union Electric Company of St. Louis,
Missouri, submitted to this Commission revised tariffs limiting
maintenance on private area and municipal incandescent lighting for
electric service provided to customers in the Missouri service area
of the Company. The proposed tariffs have a requested effective
date of January 28, 1980.

To allow sufficient time to study the effect of the proposed
changes and to determine if they are just, reasonable and in the
interest of the public, it is the opinion of the Commission the pro-
posed tariffs should be suspended for a period of one hundred twenty
(120) days beyond January 28, 1980, the requested effective date,
unless otherwise ordered by this Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That all tariff sheets submitted on December
26, 1979, by Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, for the
purpose of revising rate sheets for incandescent lighting service
provided to customers in the Missouri service area of the company,
be, and, the same is hereby suspended for a period of one hundred
twenty (120) days beyond January 28, 1980, the requested effective
date, to May 27, 1980, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on
the date hereof, and the Secretary of the Commission shall serve a
certified copy of same upon each party of record and a copy on all
other interested parties.
