MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT OF TARIFF SHEET

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company"), and pursuant to Section 393.140(11) RSMo. and 4 CSR 240-2.080(14), hereby files its Motion for Expedited Treatment of Tariff Sheets ("Motion"). In support of its *Motion*, Ameren Missouri states as follows:

1. On June 17, 2019, Ameren Missouri submitted a tariff under Tariff Tracking No. YE-2019-0225 to further revise its Rider Missouri Forward and Rider EDRR tariffs. The new tariff sheets carry an effective date of July 17, 2019.

2. On June 18, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Staff to File a Recommendation*, which provides for Staff to file a recommendation no later than July 1, 2019, and any other party to file a recommendation or respond to Staff's recommendation by July 3, 2019.

3. Ameren Missouri and Staff continued to discuss the Riders and arrived at nonsubstantive but clarifying revisions to the tariff sheets filed under Tracking No. YE-2019-0225, which are being accomplished through substitution, but also identified similar revisions to another tariff sheet, Sheet No. 86.3, that had not been submitted under Tracking No. YE-2019-0225. In order for all revisions to the Riders to go into effect at the same time, the Company requests the Commission approve Sheet No. 86.3 with an effective date of July 17, 2019.

4. The Commission's regulation 4 CSR 240-2.065(2) provides that a tariff may become effective in fewer than thirty days when a Motion for Expedited Treatment that complies

with 4 CSR 240-2.080(14) is filed. 4 CSR 240-2.080(14) dictates the following for Motions for

Expedited Treatment:

(14) Any request for expedited treatment shall include the words "Motion for Expedited Treatment" in the title of the pleading. The pleading shall also set out with particularity the following:

(A) The date by which the party desires the commission to act;

(B) The harm that will be avoided, or the benefit that will accrue, including a statement of the negative effect, or that there will be no negative effect, on the party's customers or the general public, if the commission acts by the date desired by the party; and

(C) That the pleading was filed as soon as it could have been or an explanation why it was not.

This request complies with 4 CSR 240-2.080(14) as follows:

Any request for expedited treatment shall include the words "Motion for Expedited Treatment" in the title of the pleading.

This pleading is titled "Motion for Expedited Treatment of Tariff Sheet."

(A) [The pleading shall also set out] The date by which the party desires the commission to act...

This pleading requests approval of the tariff sheet by the Commission in sufficient

time so that the tariffs can be effective by July 17, 2019.

(B) [The pleading shall also set out] The harm that will be avoided, or the benefit that will accrue, including a statement of the negative effect, or that there will be no negative effect, on the party's customers or the general public, if the commission acts by the date desired by the party...

The tariff revisions being requested will provide additional clarity with respect to the use of certain definitions and undefined terms, and incorporate recommendations made by Staff. The revisions are directly related to a substitution of certain tariff sheets in ET-2019-0149 with tariff tracking number YE-2019-0225, which have an effective date of July 17, 2019. Since Sheet No. 86.3 was not submitted in the original tariff filing, it is being submitted separately. In order for all revisions to the Riders to have the same effective

date, Ameren Missouri asked for the same effective date as YE-2019-0225, July 17, 2019. Approving the tariff sheets on fewer than thirty days' notice will not have a negative impact on the Company's customers or the general public.

(C) [The pleading shall also set out] That the pleading was filed as soon as it could have been or an explanation why it was not.

This pleading, together with the revised tariffs, was filed as soon as agreement on the tariff language for Sheet No. 86.3 was reached between the parties and could not have been submitted sooner.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and for good cause shown, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission grant this *Motion for Expedited Treatment of Tariff Sheet*, and approve the tariff sheet Ameren Missouri has filed to be effective for service rendered on and after July 17, 2019.
