ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND PROCEDURAL FILING DATE AND POSTPONE START OF HEARING

The hearing in this case is set to begin on January 31, 2022, with the parties ordered to file statements of position on January 26. On January 26, The Empire District Electric Company filed a motion asking that the start of the hearing be postponed until February 2. The motion also asks that the filing date for statements of position be extended until January 28. The motion represents that all parties either consent to, or do not oppose these requests. The Commission will grant that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Unopposed Motion to Extend Procedural Filing Date and Postpone Start of Hearing is granted.
2. The procedural schedule is modified to require the parties to file statements of position on January 28, 2022.
3. The evidentiary hearing will begin at 9:00 a.m. on February 2, 2022, and continue through February 10, 2022, as needed.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
