On May 21, 2021, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (Liberty) filed a motion seeking reconsideration or clarification of the Commission’s May 19, 2021 *Order Rejecting Tariff to Change Fuel Adjustment Rates*. On May 25, 2021, Liberty filed revised tariff language for the fuel adjustment rate tariff and Liberty and the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a joint motion for the Commission to withdraw its May 19, 2021 order and allow the substitute tariff, subject to true-up and prudence review, to take effect by operation of law on June 1, 2021. So that the Commission can consider taking action at its public meeting scheduled for May 26, 2021, at 10:15 a.m., the Commission will shorten time for responses to the joint motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any responses to the joint motion and revised tariff shall be filed no later than 9:00 a.m., May 26, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
