**ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE ABOUT PEAK USAGE DATA AND  
THE FILING OF AN UPDATED ISSUES LIST**

In Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's *Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment* it stated that the parties had reached a settlement in principle as to all issues that would affect the revenue requirement in this rate case. The remaining issues for the Commission's determination as of the filing of that motion are Class Cost of Service, Rate Design, Rate Switching Tracker, and whether Ameren Missouri should be ordered to change how property retirements are recorded to its Continuing Property Record.

There are multiple sub-issues impacted by the proposed time of use rate structures. The peak usage data contained in prefiled testimony is insufficient to assist the Commission in addressing the different time of use rate proposals. Knowing Ameren Missouri's maximum anticipated load and the times of year and day when such load is likely to occur is critical to an analysis of any time of use rate proposal. To ensure that information is presented in this case, sufficient for the Commission to make a determination, the Commission will order the filing of the following information:

1. A line graph depicting the daily maximum load (365 or 366 data points) over the test year or other appropriate twelve month time period.

2. Six separate line graphs depicting the average hourly usage by day for the months of June, July, August, December, January and February of the test year or other appropriate period.

Additionally, the Commission will order the filing of an updated issues list, so the Commission can adequately prepare for the evidentiary hearing on April 12, 2023.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than April 6, 2023, the Staff of the Commission or Ameren Missouri shall file the information requested in the body of this order.
2. No later than April 10, 2023, the Staff of the Commission shall file an updated issues list on behalf of the parties.
3. This order is effective when issued.
