12:30 p.m.)

JUDGE JORDAN: Let's go on record.

The Commission is calling the actions in
File Nos. ER-2012-0174 and 0175. These are the
general rate actions filed by Kansas City Power
& Light Company and KCPL Greater Missouri
Operations Company.

My name is Daniel Jordan. I'm the
regulatory law judge assigned to this case, and
this is the portion of this proceeding in which
we will take testimony from witnesses as to the
proposed rate increases.

City -- seated to my left is Commission
Stoll, public service commissioner.
Commissioner, would you like to make some
remarks?

COMMISSIONER STOLL: I just wanted to ask:
Who in the audience is a -- a citizen who's
here to either get -- gather information or to
observe the hearing? Right there, okay -- just
remind you that there are some -- there is some
information on the table outside that was
prepared by the staff of the Public Service

1 Commission. You might find that valuable to
2 read through. It lays out the various issues,
3 and how this -- the rate case is started, and
4 how it proceeds, and if you have any other
5 questions -- since you don't want to testify --
6 please feel free to talk to staff regarding any
7 questions you might have, but we do thank you
8 for coming today.

9 JUDGE JORDAN: I will take entries of
10 appearance on the record before I formally
11 request -- before I formally take testimony
12 from anyone who wishes to testify. We'll begin
13 with the applicants, KCPL and GMO.

14 MR. STEINER: Appearing for Kansas City
15 Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater
16 Missouri Operations Company, my name is Roger
17 W. Steiner, and I have previously given my
18 contact information to the court reporter.

19 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay, thank you. For the
20 staff of the Public Service Commission?

21 MS. McCLOWRY: Meghan McClowry for the
22 staff of the Public Service Commission. My
23 business address is P.O. Box 360, Jefferson
24 City, Missouri 65102.

25 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. For the Office

1 of the Public Counsel?

2 MR. MILLS: Appearing on behalf of the
3 Office of the Public Counsel and the Public, my
4 name is Lewis Mills. My address is Post Office
5 Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

6 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you, and do we have
7 any of the intervenors present today? I'm not
8 seeing any parties who have been granted
9 intervention.

10 I will proceed to take testimony from
11 anybody who wishes to testify. I have no names
12 on the sign-up list, but anyone present who
13 wishes to testify and tell the Commission what
14 they think about this -- about this application
15 may certainly do so.

16 I am not seeing anybody wishing to
17 testify, and so with that, I will thank
18 everybody for attending and remind those
19 attending that if anyone in the audience who
20 has any questions or comments, or thinks of
21 anything later, or whose neighbors do, they may
22 certainly contact staff for the Office of the
23 Public Counsel with those. There other ways to
24 make your -- your thoughts known as well.

25 With that, on behalf of Missouri Public

1 Service Commission and commissioners, I thank
2 you for your attendance.

3 Anything further, Commissioner?

4 COMMISSIONER STOLL: No, thank you for
5 coming out.

6 JUDGE JORDAN: Then we'll adjourn this
7 hearing, and we'll go off the record. Thank
8 you.
