P R O C E E D I N G S

JUDGE PRIDGIN: Good afternoon. We are on the record.

This is the Pre-Hearing Conference in File No. ER-2016-0285. It's In The Matter Of Kansas City Power & Light Company's Request For Authority To Implement A General Rate Increase For Electric Service.

I'm Ron Pridgin. I am the Regulatory Law Judge assigned to preside over this Pre-Hearing Conference that's being held on July 27th, 2016, in the Governor Office Building in Jefferson City, Missouri. The time is about two minutes after 1 in the afternoon.

I would like to get a verbal entries of appearance from counsel, please. I'll go down the list of everybody I think that has either -- either a party or applied to be a party, and then I'll wrap up and see if I've overlooked anyone.

If I can get entry of appearance from Kansas City Power & Light, please.

MR. STEINER: Yes. My name is Roger W. Steiner. I am appearing for Kansas City Power & Light Company. My contact information has been provided to the Court Reporter. And with me is --

MR. FISCHER: James Fischer, and I've also provided contact information. Thanks.

1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Steiner and  
2 Mr. Fisher, thank you.

3 On behalf of the Staff of the Commission,  
4 please.

5 MR. WILLIAMS. Nathan Williams, P.O. Box  
6 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.

7 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Williams, thank you.  
8 On behalf of the Office of Public  
9 Counsel, please.

10 MS. SHEMWELL: Good afternoon, Judge, and  
11 thank you. My name is Lera Shemwell, representing the  
12 Office of the Public Counsel and the Public. I've  
13 given the information to the Court Reporter.

14 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Ms. Shemwell, thank you,  
15 and welcome back.

16 MS. SHEMWELL: Thank you.

17 JUDGE PRIDGIN: On behalf of the United  
18 States Department of Energy, please.

19 MR. GARD: Yes. Hello, Judge. This is  
20 Resi Gard with the United States Department of Energy.

2 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you  
3 very much. And I'm glad you mentioned that.

4 Let me remind everybody on the phone, I'm  
5 going to go off the record in a few minutes and leave,  
6 but ask everybody on the phone to please stay on the  
7 line so you can continue to talk after I'm done. So,  
8 thank you.

9 On behalf of MCEG, please?

10 MR. WOODSMALL: Thank you, your Honor.  
11 David Woodsmall on behalf of MCEG.

12 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Woodsmall, thank you.  
13 On behalf of the City of Kansas City,  
14 please.

15 MR. COMLEY: Let the record reflect the  
16 entry of Mark W. Comley, Newman, Comley, and Ruth.  
17 Unfortunately, I haven't given the Court Reporter our  
18 contact information. It's 601 Monroe, Suite 301,

20 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Comley, thank you.  
21 On behalf of Ameren Missouri, please.  
22 (No response.)

23 JUDGE PRIDGIN: No appearance.

24 On behalf of the Sierra Club, please.

25 MR. ROBERTSON: Yes, Judge. Representing

1 both Sierra Club and Natural Resources Defense Counsel ,  
2 this is Henry Robertson, Great Rivers Environmental Law  
3 Center, 319 North 4th Street, Suite 800, St. Louis,  
4 63102.

5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Robertson, thank you.

6 On behalf of Renew Missouri , please.

7 (No response.)

8 JUDGE PRIDGIN: No appearance.

9 On behalf of Brightergy, please.

10 (No response.)

11 JUDGE PRIDGIN: No appearance.

12 On behalf of the Division of Energy,  
13 please?

14 MR. ANTAL: Good afternoon, your Honor.  
15 Alex Antal with the Missouri Department of Economic  
16 Development appearing on behalf of the Missouri  
17 Division of Energy. My address is P.O. Box 1157,  
18 Jefferson City, Missouri , 65102.

19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Antal , thank you.

20 On behalf of MIEC, please.

21 MR. MILLS: On behalf of MIEC, Lewis  
22 Mills, 221 Bolivar, Jefferson City, Missouri . I'd also  
23 like to enter the appearance of Edward Downey, also the  
24 same address, both of us at Bryan Cave, representing  
25 the MIEC.



1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Mills, thank you.

2 Have I overlooked anyone? All right.

3 MR. COFFMAN: John Coffman on behalf of  
4 Consumers Council of Missouri.

5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Coffman, I'm so  
6 sorry. I saw that on the docket sheet and I neglected  
7 to write it down. I'm sorry.

8 MR. COFFMAN: Appearing on behalf of  
9 Consumer's Counsel, I'm John B. Coffman. My address is  
10 871 Tuxedo Boulevard, St. Louis, Missouri, 63119.

11 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Mr. Coffman. Thank you.

12 Have I overlooked anyone else?

13 (No response.)

14 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you.

15 Mr. Coffman, I apologize.

16 Let me ask of KCP&L, we have several  
17 applications to intervene, some of which I realize were  
18 just filed in the last couple of days or so. So let me  
19 ask either Mr. Steiner or Mr. Fischer, whoever wants to  
20 answer, if you know yet if you have any objections to  
21 any of the applications or if you need any more time --

22 MR. STEINER: I don't believe -- I don't  
23 believe we have any objections, your Honor.

24 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. I thought  
25 there was an issue with D.O.E on Missouri Council -- I

1 think regarding Missouri Council. I don't know if  
2 that's been cleared up yet, but --

3 MR. GARD: Your Honor, this is Resi Gard  
4 from D. O. E. May I respond?

5 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Yes, sir. Please do.

6 MR. GARD: We did file an appearance  
7 today. We had identified local counsel and filed an  
8 appearance on her behalf today through the efis system.

9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Very good.  
10 You probably did that in the last hour or two; is that  
11 correct?

12 MR. GARD: That's correct, your Honor.

13 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Thank you.  
14 Yeah. I stepped out to lunch, and I saw an email and I  
15 didn't read the notice. So, it sounds like that  
16 cleared that up.

17 Any -- any further objection or anything?

18 MR. STEINER: (Witness indicates.)

19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. We'll show  
20 all the applications to intervene are granted, and I'll  
21 leave it up to counsel. If this verbal granting is  
22 enough for you, I can do that, or if you would like to  
23 have an order, I'd be happy to write that. It just  
24 takes me a few minutes. It's whatever counsel is more  
25 inclined to do, I'm glad to do it.

1 I think the only other thing I would  
2 point Counsel to before I see if you have anything for  
3 me is, is -- I've issued a preliminary schedule, I  
4 guess at least for the evidentiary hearing, and  
5 certainly willing to hear from Counsel if you have  
6 other ideas on a hearing schedule, and I think a  
7 proposed order or orders would be due Monday, August  
8 1st, if I recall correctly.

9 But because this case and the Ameren  
10 Missouri cases were filed the same day, there may be a  
11 little room to move hearing dates, but not a whole lot.  
12 So, if -- if the hearing's not going to be held on the  
13 date that's on there, it's going to have to be pretty  
14 close. And, also, I don't think my order had any sort  
15 of true-up hearing contemplated and I realize that  
16 might happen, and so you'll also have to address when,  
17 if you need a date, for a true-up hearing.

18 I don't think I have anything else for  
19 Counsel. I think we have some pleadings due Monday as  
20 far as the proposed procedural schedule, and other  
21 pleadings due in August for local public hearings.

22 Is there anything Counsel needs to bring  
23 to my attention before we go off the record and I let  
24 you continue to talk?

25 (No response.)

1 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Hearing  
2 nothing -- again, if you're on the line, please stay on  
3 the line. I'm going to go off the record and excuse  
4 myself and -- and let parties continue to talk, and  
5 that will conclude the on-the-record portion of today's  
6 Pre-Hearing Conference in ER-2016-0285.

7 Thank you very much. We are off the  
8 record.

9 (Record was closed at 1:09 p.m.)

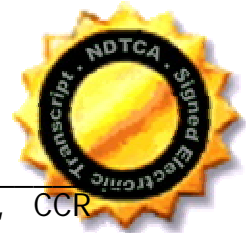
