APPLICATION

COMES NOW Empire District Industries, Inc. (hereinafter "Applicant"), a Delaware corporation, pursuant to §§392.410, 392.420, 392.440, and 392.361 RSMo. 2000, as amended, and 4 CSR 240-2.060(6), and files this verified Application requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (hereinafter "Commission") issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Local Exchange and Intrastate Interexchange Service Authority to provide telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Missouri Revised Statutes, as hereinafter described;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant; and
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to §392.420 RSMo. 2000.

In support of this request, Applicant states that:

1. Applicant is a Delaware corporation with its principal office and place of business at 602 Joplin Street, Joplin, Missouri 64801. Applicant is qualified to do business in the State of Missouri. Applicant proposes to engage, generally, in the business of providing fiber-optic services as hereinafter described. In addition, it is anticipated that Applicant will take over and continue uninterrupted the regulated telecommunications services currently provided by its parent company, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire"). Empire previously received from this Commission a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and, also, local exchange telecommunications services in the form of

dedicated, non-switched local exchange private line service in an order dated January 22, 1998, in Commission Case No. TA-98-233. A copy of the Commission's Order Approving Interexchange and Local Exchange Certificates of Service Authority and Order Approving Tariff is attached hereto as Appendix 1.

- 2. Attached hereto as **Appendix 2** and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes is a copy of a Certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office evidencing that Applicant is authorized to do business in the State of Missouri as a foreign corporation.
- 3. Applicant has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involves customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.
 - 4. Applicant has no annual report or assessment fees that are overdue.

6. Applicant proposes to undertake to conduct the regulated telecommunications business currently being conducted by its parent, Empire. Specifically, Applicant proposes to

provide:

- (a) dedicated, non-switched point-to-point and point-to-multipoint private line telecommunications, which both originate and terminate within an exchange; and
- (b) interexchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Missouri.

Generally, Applicant proposes to provide fiber or circuit capacity and services on a fiber optic network. Applicant will provide capacity on said fiber optic network to schools and school districts and hospitals and health care providers for the purpose of making available distance learning and telemedicine capabilities and, also, to businesses and communications common carriers. Applicant may also provide a competitive access services to interexchange carriers, internet access and other data or communications services to others. Applicant has no plans to provide two-way switched voice service within a local calling scope and no immediate plans to provide message telecommunications service (i.e., toll services). Applicant will utilize its own facilities, or purchase for resale the services or facilities of other companies in order to provide the described facilities and services.

- 7. Applicant proposes to charge for facilities and services provided based on rates, rules and regulations as proposed in the tariffs attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Appendix 3** and bearing an effective date of September 13, 2002. Said tariffs are nearly identical to the tariffs pursuant to which Empire currently provides regulated telecommunications services.
- 8. Applicant requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant believes that its proposed services would be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. Granting this Application will allow greater price and service options for telecommunications customers. See, Re Digital Teleport, 1

Mo.P.S.C.3d 303, 307 (1992). Furthermore, the identical services currently provided by Empire have heretofore been classified as competitive by the Commission in its Case No. TA-98-233.

9. Applicant also requests, pursuant to §392.420 RSMo. 2000, that the Commission waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of Applicant:

It is Applicant's understanding that the above-referenced rules and statutory provisions have routinely been waived for other competitive telecommunications companies.

- 10. Applicant possesses sufficient technical, financial and managerial resources and abilities to provide the facilities and interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications services for which certification is being requested.
- enter is sufficiently competitive so as to justify a lesser degree of regulation. In the case of *Re Classification of Services Provided by Interexchange Telecommunications Carriers Within the State of Missouri*, Case No. TO-88-142, Report and Order, effective October 16, 1989, at pages 19-20. Expeditious granting of the instant Application will increase the competition in the provisions of communications facilities and interexchange services, consistent with the Commission's policies and, also, increase the variety and number of interexchange telecommunications providers and services available to users. Approval of this Application is consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Accordingly, Applicant's proposed operations are in the public interest.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Service Authority to provided dedicated, non-switched local exchange private line telecommunications services and intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to the public in the State of Missouri. Applicant also requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company. In addition, Applicant requests a waiver of the above-referenced rules and statutory provisions.



ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE AND LOCAL EXCHANGE CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

The Empire District Electric Company (Empire) applied to the Public Service Commission on December 5, 1997, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.410-.450, RSMo 1994¹. Empire subsequently filed an Amended Application by Interlineation which included a Certificate of Corporate Good Standing-Foreign Corporation from the Missouri Secretary of State. Empire asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. Empire is a Kansas corporation, with its principal office located at 602 Joplin Street, Joplin, Missouri 64801.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on December 9, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by December 24. The requirement for a hearing is met when

the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel.

Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

Empire filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application and filed a substitute sheet on January 9, 1998. The tariff's effective date is January 26, 1998. Empire's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies Empire as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. Empire intends to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services including private line services.

The Staff of the Commission filed a Memorandum recommending approval of Empire's application and tariff on January 7, 1998. Staff subsequently filed an amended recommendation on January 14. In its amended recommendation, Staff stated that Empire's proposed services are similar to existing IXC offerings. Staff recommended that the Commission grant Empire a certificate of interexchange service authority, and a certificate of service authority for local exchange telecommunication services on condition that this authority be restricted to providing dedicated, nonswitched local exchange private line services. Staff recommended that the Commission grant Empire competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff to become effective on January 26, 1998.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunications markets is in the

public interest and Empire should be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services Empire proposes to offer are competitive and Empire should be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in Ordered Paragraph 3 is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that Empire's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated interexchange and local exchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on December 5 shall be approved as amended to become effective on January 26, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That The Empire District Electric Company is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- 2. That The Empire District Electric Company is granted a certificate of service authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri limited to providing dedicated, nonswitched local exchange private line services, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.
- . 3. That The Empire District Electric Company is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:


