i. 20.094(9)(B)1.A. -- "A. Develop statewide protocols for evaluation, measurement, and verification of energy efficiency savings, no later than December 31, 2018, and update those protocols annually thereafter;..."

b. Discuss the evolution rule update - Renew MO request and Commission comments

i. Originally Renew MO's suggestion in rulemaking because "regulators and utilities spend large amounts of time arguing over the results of EM&V, primarily because the parties do not have a shared methodology for how to count savings for particular measures."

- ii. Commission comment from rule making:
- While EM&V practices may vary widely at this time, the development of statewide protocols can still be helpful. Ameren Missouri is correct that the idea that the statewide collaborative can implement statewide protocols implies the collaborative has more authority than it does. The commission will change "create and implement statewide protocols" to "develop statewide protocols" in recognition that the statewide collaborative does not have authority to dictate to the electric utilities.
